

Grace Apostolic Church Public Health & Safety Guidelines

With respect to the Pandemic of the Coronavirus, Covid-19, we issue the following statements: We encourage a culture of faith, not of fear. Additionally, we encourage culture of prevention, not of paranoia. We want to ensure all of our congregants and attendees of our efforts to provide a clean and safe environment.

We ask that all persons please respect and follow the guidelines listed below:

1. Please wash or sanitize your hands before entering the Sanctuary as well as when you leave. Hand sanitizers are located outside of the Sanctuary, both in the front and in the rear. Facial masks and gloves may be worn and, in some cases of operation, required.
2. All congregants and attendees are asked to maintain a physical separation of approximately six feet as you are seated, unless from the same household.
3. We recommend that all persons avoid unnecessary physical contact.
4. Anyone who has a fever, or any significant underlying health condition, should stay home until health is recovered.
5. All parents are asked to keep their children seated with you or members of your family.
6. During church services, anyone displaying cold-like symptoms, including but not limited to excessive coughing, sneezing, or cold chills, are kindly asked to return home to insure the health of others.
7. We request that anyone who has traveled overseas recently to please remain at home from services until symptom-free or at least 14 days.
8. We encourage all persons who are fearful, immune compromised, or have a vulnerable pulmonary system to please stay at home until/unless you become physically well.
9. During our Offering/Tithes, all persons giving electronically are asked to maintain a line of no more than five persons at a time. Please notice markers on the floor for proper spacing as you approach the credit card machine.
10. Please follow the Pastor's instructions for all corporate physical movement during the service.
